INTELLIGENCE AND BODY LANGUAGE

Main subject: *Intelligence and the Gathering of Information*
Secondary Course: *Body Language as an Identification Tool in a Security System*

OBJECTIVES: To learn the structure of an intelligence system. To learn and practice methods in activating and operating sources of information.

To learn the language that *never lies* and how to detect suspicious signs that indicate an intention to lie or cause harm. To manage a basic quick questioning process to discover the truth.
