BODY LANGUAGE AND ACCESS CONTROL

Main subject: *Body Language as an Identification Tool in a Security System*
Secondary Course: *Access and Passage Control in Strategic Secured Sites*

OBJECTIVES: To learn the language that *never lies* and how to detect suspicious signs that indicate an intention to lie or cause harm. To become familiar with the methods and practices of the questioning process in discovering the truth and achieving the skills to transmit power and intention via body language.

To learn the structure of a unit that conduct access control and become familiar with the principles of combining intelligence, procedures, modern means and training of personnel. Learn methods of controlling the passage from one security classified area to another.
